Temporary Covid legislation removed the statutory requirement for a Parish Meeting in 2020 and allowed local councils to hold meetings by video conferencing. This legislation expired on 7<sup>th</sup> May and the Government decided not to renew it. As a consequence, it is a requirement to hold an Annual Parish Meeting by 1st June and for this to be an in-person meeting. I recognise that many parishioners who wish to attend may not be comfortable with this so I intend to hold a further public meeting later in the year where there will be full reports from Councillors and the opportunity for a fuller discussion.
