Privacy Notice

What personal data do we collect?

The data we collect are names, postal addresses, and email addresses when members join the Society.

What is this data used for?

We use members' data for communication of information, notice of AGMs and other events.

Who is your data shared with?

The data are not passed to other organisations.

Where does the data come from?

Personal data comes from the members on joining or when they update the information.

How is the data stored?

The information is stored in digital form on computers in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Who is responsible for ensuring compliance with GDPR?

The person responsible is the Honorary Secretary.

Who has access to the data?

Only the Chair, Honorary Treasurer and Honorary Secretary of The Hadstock Society have access to the data.

What is the legal basis for collecting the personal data?

The personal data is necessary for the purposes of the Society's 'legitimate interests' as a membership organisation.

How can you check what data we have about you?

You should contact the Honorary Secretary.

Can you ask for the data to be removed, limited or corrected?

Yes. You should contact the Honorary Secretary.

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
